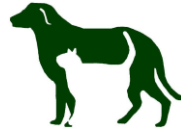


Red Leash Society

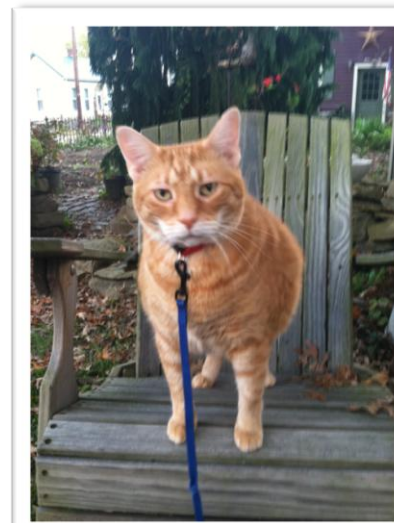
